## AUTUMN TERM ARRANGEMENTS 2021

We have completed the risk assessment process taking into account Government and Local Authority advice. The risk assessment and any other relevant documents will be sent to you for consultation early this term. The arrangements from Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> September will be:

School Day Starts - 8.50am School Day Ends - F2 & KS1 3.25pm KS2 3.30pm

In the morning, children will line up outside of their designated entrance with the appropriate member of staff. The Glenwood entrance will be open. We ask that all parents to not gather on school grounds and enter and leave promptly. There is no requirement to wear a mask on school grounds although we would encourage parents and children to remain in family groups.

For the first two weeks we ask that children wear their school PE kit to school on PE days (no football kits). This will be reviewed.

A timetable of assemblies will take place daily in the hall (two or three classes to start with), playtimes and lunchtimes will return to normal timings and structure, with year groups allowed to socialise on the school playground.

PE sessions will start from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September.

We will continue to encourage children to limit the items they carry to and from school. Children may bring a school bag, reading bag, lunchbox, water bottle and hat/gloves, etc as appropriate. We will continue to provide children with a stationery set to reduce the sharing of resources and thus any transmission. If your child does bring a pencil case to school then we ask that it remains in school and that it is for only your child's use.

We will of course keep you up to date with Covid related matters and continue to revise our risk assessments and protocols accordingly. Kind Regards
