



WRITTEN STATEMENT OF BEHAVIOUR PRINCIPLES

- Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and learn free from the disruption of others.
- All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination.
- Staff, volunteers and visitors role model our consistently high expectations of conduct and behaviour to pupils at all times.
- Rewards, sanctions and reasonable force are used consistently by staff as identified the behaviour policy.
- The behaviour policy is understood by pupils, staff and parents.
- The exclusions policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort, and outlines the processes involved in permanent and fixed-term exclusions.
- Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions.
- Families are involved in nurturing high expectations of behaviour and addressing behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life.
